**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE SCHEDULES AND STATEMENTS**

Upon the Motion (the "Motion") of Crescent Resources, LLC and its affiliated debtors, as debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1007(c) for an order extending the time in which the Debtors must file their Schedules and Statements¹, as more fully described in the Motion; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief sought therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Motion and the requested relief being a core proceeding in the Bankruptcy

Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Motion having been provided to the parties listed therein; and the relief requested in the Motion being in the best interests of the Debtors and their respective estates and creditors; and the Court having reviewed the Motion and having held a hearing (the "Hearing") with appearances of parties in interest noted on the record thereof; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion and at the Hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The time within which the Debtors must file their Schedules and Statements under Bankruptcy Rule 1007 is extended by an additional 30 days, for a total of 45 days after the Commencement Date, through and including July 27, 2009.
2. The relief granted in this Order is without prejudice to the right of the Debtors to request a further extension of time to file the Schedules and Statements, should the Debtors deem such further extension necessary.
3. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from the interpretation or implementation of this Order.
